Phonics

The Reading Ready program is designed to give students a solid foundation in: phonological awareness, letter identification, letter sounds, and handwriting. Students will learn the appropriate articulation of letter sounds and focus on beginning sounds in words. They will progress through the alphabet in alphabetical order.

Reading Comprehension

Students will listen to a variety of literature, learning different reading comprehension strategies which include: retelling, story sequencing (beginning, middle & end), identifying main characters, as well as settings and events.
